Our initiatives include


- Develop a shared understanding of 'data literacy' and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching
- Implement a whole school approach to teaching literacy across all year levels
- Build teacher capability to use technology to differentiate and improve learning

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Engage the services of an experienced teacher/HOC and provide TRS to release teachers to develop programs/materials to use in working with students on particular learning goals and to provide professional development to staff in gradually shifting responsibility to students, monitoring techniques and extending students' thinking \$50000
- Provide TRS to enable teams of teachers/leaders to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations \$20000
- Engage the services of teacher aides to work in teams to provide targeted support for students during Literacy Blocks \$83,295
